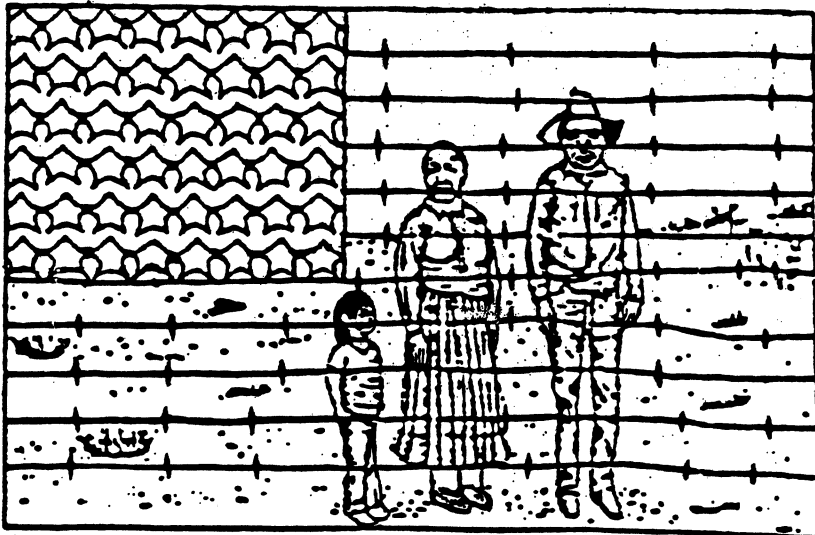

THE CHARGE

Forced relocation of traditional Navajo people from Big Mountain has "subject(ed) the group to conditions of life that....cause the physical destruction of the group" and has "cause(d) the permanent impairment of the mental faculties of members of the group." Either consequence is defined as genocide in the "Genocide Convention Implementation Act of 1987", P.L. 100-606.
