City, S.D.) informed me that the program was voluntary and that it
was shown to be safe. We came across a letter from the Human
Subjects Review Coordinator to Dr. Craigh Shapiro (Division of
Viral Disease) which criticized the proposed characterization of the
vaccine as "safe" since the absolute statement should not be made
that the vaccine has been shown to be safe."
